Rodrigues (Sale of Drugs) Regulations, 1958

GN No. 45 of 1958 21st June

Regulations made by the Governor in Council under Section 158 of the Courts Ordinance

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rodrigues (Sale of Drugs) Regulations, 1958.
- 2. In these Regulations "Medicine "means any chemical product, pharmaceutical preparation, patent, secret or proprietary medicine, vaccine, serum or other substance for use in medicine, dental and veterinary work.
- 3.(1) No person other than a pharmacist shall sell, offer or expose for sale in Rodrigues any medicine:-

Provided that the Director of Medical Services may authorise the sale by traders of such medicines as he may deem advisable,

- (2) A list containing the name and description of any medicine, the sale of which is authorised as aforesaid, and bearing the signature and Stamp of the Director of Medical Services shall be posted up in a conspicuous place in the office of the Magistrate and Civil Commissioner.
- 4. Any person selling, offering or exposing for sale any medicine in breach of the provisions of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.

Made by the Governor in Council on the thirtieth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifty eight and ordered to come into force at once.
