

## **Procedure for Application for Pupillage**

When applying for pupillage at the ODPP, prospective barristers should take the following into consideration:

- Applicants should include their name, correspondence address, email address and telephone number.
- Prospective barristers should attach their certificates, i.e. School Certificate, Higher School Certificate, Bachelor of Laws official certificate, Master of Laws (if any), Bar Practice Certificate and Call certificate.
- The minimum pupillage period is three months, and the maximum period is six months.
- Prospective Barristers should submit their applications on [hr\\_dpp@govmu.org](mailto:hr_dpp@govmu.org)
- Once approval has been obtained from the Council for Vocational Legal Education, no amendments or changes to the period of pupillage will be considered.
- To select the best candidates, applicants may be invited for an interview.
